CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

R.J. Cole, G, Howard

Cole averaged 28 points, six rebounds, three steals and three assists in his lone game this past weekend as the Bison won their third straight contest. The 6-1 Union, N.J. native also shot 55 percent from the field while draining five three-pointers.

Jermaine Marrow, G, Hampton

Marrow finished the past cycle averaging 25 points, eight rebounds, seven assists and two steals while also shooting 95.5 (21-of-22) percent from the free throw line. Against Bethune-Cookman on Monday night, the Newport News, Va. native narrowly missed a triple-double by one assist after scoring a career-high 35 points. His 15-of-16 (93.7 percent) performance from the free throw line is the ninth best mark in a single game in school history.

ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Marquis Collins, G/F, Delaware State

Collins exploded for a career-high 30 points on Saturday night as he was near-perfect from the field (11-of-13). The 6-7 guard/forward from Chester, Pa., Collins nailed four three-pointers while grabbing three rebounds and blocking one shot.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Damani Applewhite, F, South Carolina State

Applewhite averaged 10.5 rebounds, 1.5 blocks and a steal over the past two games for South Carolina State. The 6-8 forward from Fayetteville, N.C. opened the weekend with a nine-rebound, two-block, one steal outing at Coppin State before closing the cycle out with 12 rebounds, a block and a steal in the win at Morgan State.

All About The Bears

Morgan State was picked first for the fourth time under head coach **Todd Bozeman**. The last time Morgan State was picked to finish first in the preseason polls was during the 2011-12 season, a season in which the Bears fell to Hampton in the First Round of the MEAC Tournament (69-65). The Bears were also selected to capture first place in the MEAC during the 2008-09 and 2009-10 seasons -- winning the MEAC regular season titles and Tournament championships in both seasons.

Morgan State senior forward **Phillip Carr** was selected as the MEAC Preseason Player of the Year after he was named the 2016-17 MEAC Defensive Player of the Year and All-MEAC First Teamer.

Carr was named the 2016-17 MEAC Defensive Player of the Year and was named All-MEAC First Team. He was the MEAC's top rebounder with 9.5 rebounds per contest and ranked seventh in scoring averaging 16.6 points. Carr was also named to the BOXTOROW Division I All-America Team, the ABC All-District First Team, and the ECAC All-Star Second Team last season. He ended his junior campaign leading the league with 11 double-doubles (points and rebounds) and recorded 22 blocks and 15 steals on the season for the Bears. A two-time MEAC Player of the Week, Carr becomes the first Bear to be named the MEAC Preseason Player of the Year since **Kevin Thompson** before his senior season in 2010. **Reggie Holmes** is the last Bear to win the regular-season award, when he received the award in 2009.

Teammate **Tiwian Kindley** who was the MEAC's leading scorer after averaging 21 points per game last season, also returns for the Bears as he was named to the first team.

Morgan State picked up the MEAC's first NCAA Division I win this season as they defeated South Florida in November.

Shift In Firepower

Last season, the MEAC returned a plethora of scorers from the previous season as four of the top 10 scorers from 2015-16 returned for the 2016-17 campaign.

The 2017-18 campaign starts out with more firepower as five of last year's top 10 scorers return led by Morgan State's **Tiwian Kindley** (21 ppg), Bethune-Cookman's **Brandon Tabb** (17.8 ppg), Morgan State's **Phillip Carr** (16.6 ppg), Savannah State's **Dexter McClanahan** (16.4 ppg) and Florida A&M's **Desmond Williams** (16.2 ppg).

Something About Hampton

If a coach wants to jump start a career, its best to swing by Hampton University as three coaches in the MEAC have either served or are serving as a head coach for the Pirates.

Maryland Eastern Shore's **Bobby Collins** coached there from 2002-06 while Howard's **Kevin Nickelberry** began his career there in 2006 and coached there until 2009 before giving way to current coach **Ed Joyner, Jr.**

All-Time Marks

With the exception of Florida A&M, every team in the MEAC has won a regular season title since its inception. Every team with the exception of Savannah State, Bethune-Cookman and Maryland Eastern Shore has participated in the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament.

North Carolina A&T State has 11 regular season titles followed by 10 from Coppin State and seven from South Carolina State.

Non-Conference Report

Last season, the MEAC finished 42-129 (.246 pct.) versus non-conference opponents. They were a perfect 10 versus NAIA programs, 7-1 against NCAA Division II opponents and 5-0 against NCAA Division III opponents. The MEAC picked up major college wins against teams from the Big East, Pac 12 and SEC.

Have To Go Through Norfolk State

The Norfolk State Spartans are the model of consistency for the MEAC as the Spartans have posted 19 consecutive seasons with a .500 or better conference record in its Division I era.

The Spartans also continued their streak of finishing no worse than tied for third each of the last six years, the only program in the league to do so. NSU is just one of 14 schools in the nation

to finish in the top 3 in the league standings each of the last six years.

NSU also boasts the lone active MEAC NBA player in **Kyle O'Quinn** as he plays for the New York Knicks.

Mystery Team

Last year's MEAC Tournament and Regular Season Champion North Carolina Central enter the season as one of the biggest unknowns on paper.

NCCU finished 2016-17 with a 25-9 overall record and a 13-3 MEAC mark. The Eagles lost all five starters from last year's team and eight lettermen.

Darkhorse

Hampton enters this season somewhat under the radar despite returning an experienced squad and one of the MEAC's most exciting sophomores in **Jermaine Marrow**.

The Pirates finished third last season under current coach **Ed Joyner, Jr.** and have finished no less than sixth since 2011-12.

Sophomore Sensation

Howard's **Charles Williams** enters with high expectations as he's coming off a freshman campaign that saw him average 15.6 points per game. Williams is back to form as he's averaging 19.9 points per game this season.

The 2016-17 MEAC Rookie of the Year is the top rookie back from last season's all-rookie team which returns four of its five members.

Is It The Water?

While the MEAC spans seven states and Washington, D.C., one area in particular has become fertile recruiting ground for the conference as several of the MEAC's top scorers hail from this area.

The Hampton Roads and Richmond, Va. area has proven to be a productive area as three of the top 15 scorers in the MEAC from last season are from the area in **Brandon Tabb** of Bethune-Cookman (Hampton), **Charles Williams** (Howard/Richmond), **Jermaine Marrow** (Hampton/Newport News).

Threes Please

The MEAC is an exciting place to watch the long ball.

Howard's **RJ Cole** leads the way with 76 treys followed by **Donte Wright** of South Carolina State (69). **Brandon Tabb** of Bethune-Cookman follows with 68.

As a team, Savannah State leads the way with 267 three-pointers made and 898 three-point attempts.

Welcome To The MEAC

The MEAC features a trio of new head coaches as **Juan Dixon** takes over at Coppin State while **Robert McCullum** assumes the reigns at Florida A&M. **Ryan Ridder** assumes command of the Wildcat basketball program in Bethune-Cookman. Out of the trio, Ridder has had the most success early on as BCU is undefeated in league play.

Cole-Blooded Freshmen

Howard freshman **R.J. Cole** arrived to the Howard campus with an abundance of fanfare from high school and has lived up to the hype so far as he's averaging 23.6 points after 23 games and a nine-time MEAC Rookie of the Week.

While Cole has come on strong, fellow freshman NCCU's **Reginald Gardner, Jr.'s** 11.8 points per game ranks second amongst freshmen followed by **Mirryne Thomas** of Maryland Eastern Shore (10.7 ppg).

Surprise, Surprise

After winning four games in 2016-17, North Carolina A&T State has surpassed its output from the previous season as the Aggies are 12-9 with two non-conference road wins at Jacksonville and East Carolina. The Aggies are 13-9 overall and tied for first in the MEAC with a 6-1 mark.

Bethune-Cookman also has caught fire this season as the Wildcats are 11-11 overall but have dropped two straight after a 5-0 conference start. BCU was off to its best start in MEAC play since 2011.

Last year's defending champion North Carolina Central has proven that they will be a factor in league play despite heavy roster losses with two losses in MEAC competition.

Savannah State has emerged as a darkhorse in the MEAC standings with a 6-1 mark. The Tigers are tied with North Carolina A&T State for first.

Double Trouble

Morgan State's **Phillip Carr** leads the MEAC with 11 double-doubles on the season while BCU's **Shawntrez Davis** and **Soufiyane Diakite** follows with eight apiece. North Carolina A&T State's **Femi Olujobi** has seven double-doubles on the season.

Inside Play

Based on the returns from this year's play, the MEAC looks to have solid inside play in addition to its consistent guard play with four players averaging eight or more rebounds.

Bethune-Cookman's **Soufiyane Diakite** and Morgan State's **Philip Carr** rank 1-2 with 9.4 and nine rebounds per game, respectively. Fellow BCU teammate **Shawntrez Davis** follows with 8.2 rebounds while North Carolina A&T State's **Femi Olujobi** averages eight boards.

North Carolina Central's **Raasean Davis** ranks second nationally in field goal percentage with a 69 percent clip. **Brandon**

Tabb of BCU ranks 14th with 3.4 treys per game and fourth with a 92.5 percent free throw average.

Howard's **RJ Cole** stands first in total field goal attempts (430), seventh with 23.4 points per game, 14th in total assists with 135, first in total minutes and eighth in free throws made (134).

Charles Williams of Howard ranks eighth in total field goals made with 176 and seventh in total field goal attempts (392).

It's Early But....

Even though its early, this year's MEAC race has the potential to come down to the final buzzer in early March. In the first week alone, nine of the first 15 games played in the MEAC have been decided by six points or less. In week two, five of the 12 games played that weekend were decided by six points or less. Week three featured another close bout of games with seven games decided by six or less points while week four had four games decided by the aforementioned span.

Oh So Close

Howard University has been on the rough end of the ledger in MEAC play as the Bison have lost four games by eight points or less, including consecutive overtime games. The Bison finally stepped into the winner's column in typical Bison fashion with a pair of overtime wins over North Carolina A&T State and North Carolina Central on the weekend of Jan. 20 and have won three straight as of now.

Maryland Eastern Shore has also struggled towards the end as the Hawks have lost seven league games by a combined 39 points.

Coppin State has quietly emerged after a slow start with three straight wins by an average of six points.

Over, Over and Over

MEAC fans have received plenty of free action this season with a total of 15 overtime games in conference contests. Howard leads the way with four OT games.

We Can Score & Share Also

A pair of high scorers in the MEAC also have done a solid job of distributing the ball as Howard's **R.J. Cole** leads the MEAC with 5.9 assists per game along with Hampton's **Jermaine Marrow** (5.7). Maryland Eastern

Shore's **Logan McIntosh** ranks third with 4.9 along with North Carolina Central's **Jordan Perkins** (4.9).

Cole leads the MEAC in scoring (23.6) while Marrow ranks third (19.9).

Return With a Vengeance

Morgan State's **Tiwian Kendley** has returned to the court with a vengeance as he's averaging 26.6 points in 11 games played. He has scored 30-plus points during a four-game span this season.

Don't Count Them Out

Last year's MEAC runner-up Norfolk State had to make adjustments on the fly entering the start of the 2017-18 campaign. The Spartans best two returnees in point guard **Zaynah Robinson** and forward **Jordan Butler** are red-shirting coupled with the loss of their top scorer due to graduation.

In Our Prayers

South Carolina State suffered an unfortunate setback on Dec. 2 when guard **Ty Solomon** collapsed at North Carolina State. Solomon was released from the hospital several days later and visited the team the same day he was released.

2018 ESPN TV Schedule

Four regular season games and 23 tournament games on the ESPN family of networks highlights the 2018 Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference men's basketball TV schedule.

The schedule tips off on Monday, Feb. 5 as defending MEAC regular season and tournament North Carolina Central hosts Hampton for a 7 p.m. start. Despite losing the core of last year's team to graduation, the Eagles look to have offset the departures with solid play in non-conference action. The second week of action features Delaware State at 2016-17 MEAC regular season and tournament runner-up Norfolk State on Feb. 12 at 7 p.m.

North Carolina Central is back on the tubes once again two weeks later as they'll welcome Howard to Durham, N.C. on Feb. 19. The final ESPNU regular season contest tips off on Monday, Feb. 26 as Norfolk State travels to Howard.

The entire 2018 MEAC Tournament (men's & women's) will be shown live on ESPN3. In addition to the ESPN3 broadcast, the men's championship game will broadcast live on ESPN2 at 1 p.m. on Saturday, March 11 while the women's

contest will rebroadcast on ESPNU at 12 p.m. on Sunday, March 12.

2017-18 PRESEASON ALL-MEAC TEAM / PREDICTED ORDER OF FINISH

Morgan State senior forward Phillip Carr was selected as the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) Men's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year, the conference announced today. Morgan State was selected as the preseason favorite to win the MEAC this coming season.

All awards are voted on by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors.

Carr was named the 2016-17 MEAC Defensive Player of the Year and was named All-MEAC First Team. He was the MEAC's top rebounder with 9.5 rebounds per contest and ranked seventh in scoring averaging 16.6 points. Carr was also named to the BOXTOROW Division I All-America Team, the ABC All-District First Team, and the ECAC All-Star Second Team last season. He ended his junior campaign leading the league with 11 double-doubles (points and rebounds) and recorded 22 blocks and 15 steals on the season for the Bears. A two-time MEAC Player of the Week, Carr becomes the first Bear to be named the MEAC Preseason Player of the Year since Kevin Thompson before his senior season in 2010. Reggie Holmes is the last Bear to win the regular-season award, when he received the award in 2009.

Morgan State, which finished 11-5 in conference play season, picked up 13 first-place votes as this marks the first time since 2011-12 that the Bears were predicted to win the MEAC. Under the guidance of 12th year head coach Todd Bozeman, the Bears were also selected to capture first place in the MEAC during the 2008-09 and 2009-10 seasons. Norfolk State was picked to finish second, while defending MEAC regular season and postseason champions North Carolina Central was picked to finish third.

Rounding out the rest of the preseason poll are Hampton, Savannah State, Maryland Eastern Shore, S.C. State, Howard, Bethune Cookman, Delaware State, Florida A&M, Coppin State, and North Carolina A&T State.

Joining Carr on the Preseason All-MEAC First Team are Norfolk State's Zaynah Robinson, Bethune Cookman's Brandon Tabb, Howard's Charles Williams and Morgan State's Tiwian Kindley.

The 2017-18 season begins on Friday, Nov. 10 while the 2018 MEAC Basketball Tournament will be held March 5-10 at the Norfolk Scope Arena in Norfolk, Va.
