CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

R.J. Cole, G, Howard

James Richardson, G, South Carolina State

He shot 51.7 percent from the field and 70 percent from the charity stripe. Against Charleston Southern, Richardson scored 26 points on 9-of-17 shooting with four steals and two blocks.

The MEAC sponsors 16 Division I (FCS) sports with automatic qualifying bids for NCAA postseason competition in baseball, bowling, men's and women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, men's and women's tennis, men's and women's track and field, softball, volleyball and men's golf.

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All About The Bears

Morgan State was picked first for the fourth time under head coach **Todd Bozeman**. The last time Morgan State was picked to finish first in the preseason polls was during the 2011-12 season, a season in which the Bears fell to Hampton in the First Round of the MEAC Tournament (69-65). The Bears were also selected to capture first place in the MEAC during the 2008-09 and 2009-10 seasons -- winning the MEAC regular season titles and Tournament championships in both seasons.

Morgan State senior forward **Phillip Carr** was selected as the MEAC Preseason Player of the Year after he was named the 2016-17 MEAC Defensive Player of the Year and All-MEAC First Teamer.

Carr was named the 2016-17 MEAC Defensive Player of the Year and was named All-MEAC First Team. He was the MEAC's top rebounder with 9.5 rebounds per contest and ranked seventh in scoring averaging 16.6 points. Carr was also named to the BOXTOROW Division I All-America Team, the ABC All-District First Team, and the ECAC All-Star Second Team last season. He ended his junior campaign leading the league with 11 double-doubles (points and rebounds) and recorded 22 blocks and 15 steals on the season for the Bears. A two-time MEAC Player of the Week, Carr becomes the first Bear to be named the MEAC Preseason Player of the Year since **Kevin Thompson** before his senior season in 2010. **Reggie Holmes** is the last Bear to win the regular-season award, when he received the award in 2009.

Teammate **Tiwian Kindley** who was the MEAC's leading scorer after averaging 21 points per game last season, also returns for the Bears as he was named to the first team.

Morgan State picked up the MEAC's first NCAA Division I win this season as they defeated South Florida in November.

Shift In Firepower

Last season, the MEAC returned a plethora of scorers from the previous season as four of the top 10 scorers from 2015-16 returned for the 2016-17 campaign.

The 2017-18 campaign starts out with more firepower as five of last year's top 10 scorers return led by Morgan State's **Tiwian Kindley** (21 ppg), Bethune-Cookman's **Brandon Tabb** (17.8 ppg), Morgan State's **Phillip Carr** (16.6 ppg), Savannah State's **Dexter McClanahan** (16.4 ppg) and Florida A&M's **Desmond Williams** (16.2 ppg).

Something About Hampton

If a coach wants to jump start a career, its best to swing by Hampton University as three coaches in the MEAC have either served or are serving as a head coach for the Pirates.

Maryland Eastern Shore's **Bobby Collins** coached there from 2002-06 while Howard's **Kevin Nickelberry** began his career there in 2006 and coached there until 2009 before giving way to current coach **Ed Joyner, Jr.**

All-Time Marks

With the exception of Florida A&M, every team in the MEAC has won a regular season title since its inception. Every team with the exception of Savannah State, Bethune-Cookman and Maryland Eastern Shore has participated in the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament.

North Carolina A&T State has 11 regular season titles followed by 10 from Coppin State and seven from South Carolina State.

Non-Conference Report

Last season, the MEAC finished 42-129 (.246 pct.) versus non-conference opponents. They were a perfect 10 versus NAIA programs, 7-1 against NCAA Division II opponents and 5-0 against NCAA Division III opponents. The MEAC picked up major college wins against teams from the Big East, Pac 12 and SEC.

Have To Go Through Norfolk State

The Norfolk State Spartans are the model of consistency for the MEAC as the Spartans have posted 19 consecutive seasons with a .500 or better conference record in its Division I era.

The Spartans also continued their streak of finishing no worse than tied for third each of the last six years, the only program in the league to do so. NSU is just one of 14 schools in the nation

to finish in the top 3 in the league standings each of the last six years.

NSU also boasts the lone active MEAC NBA player in **Kyle O'Quinn** as he plays for the New York Knicks.

Mystery Team

Last year's MEAC Tournament and Regular Season Champion North Carolina Central enter the season as one of the biggest unknowns on paper.

NCCU finished 2016-17 with a 25-9 overall record and a 13-3 MEAC mark. The Eagles lost all five starters from last year's team and eight lettermen.

Darkhorse

Hampton enters this season somewhat under the radar despite returning an experienced squad and one of the MEAC's most exciting sophomores in **Jermaine Marrow**.

The Pirates finished third last season under current coach **Ed Joyner, Jr.** and have finished no less than sixth since 2011-12.

Sophomore Sensation

Howard's **Charles Williams** enters with high expectations as he's coming off a freshman campaign that saw him average 15.6 points per game. Williams is back to form as he's averaging 18.1 points per game this season.

The 2016-17 MEAC Rookie of the Year is the top rookie back from last season's all-rookie team which returns four of its five members.

Is It The Water?

While the MEAC spans seven states and Washington, D.C., one area in particular has become fertile recruiting ground for the conference as several of the MEAC's top scorers hail from this area.

The Hampton Roads and Richmond, Va. area has proven to be a productive area as three of the top 15 scorers in the MEAC from last season are from the area in **Brandon Tabb** of Bethune-Cookman (Hampton), **Charles Williams** (Howard/Richmond), **Jermaine Marrow** (Hampton/Newport News).

Threes Please

The MEAC will once again be an exciting place to watch the long ball as Maryland Eastern Shore's **Ryan Andino** and Bethune-Cookman's **Brandon Tabb** return as they finished 1-2 in three-pointers made last season.

Donte Wright of South Carolina State leads the way with 46 treys made while FAMU's **Marcus Barham** follows with 36. Bethune-Cookman's **Brandon Tabb** has made 35 treys while Howard's **RJ Cole** has nailed 32.

Welcome To The MEAC

The MEAC features a trio of new head coaches as **Juan Dixon** takes over at Coppin State while **Robert McCullum** assumes the reigns at Florida A&M. **Ryan Ridder** assumes command of the Wildcat basketball program in Bethune-Cookman.

Cole-Blooded Freshmen

Howard freshman **R.J. Cole** arrived to the Howard campus with an abundance of fanfare from high school and has lived up to the hype so far as he's averaging 20.4 points after 13 games and a four-time MEAC Rookie of the Week.

While Cole has come on strong, fellow freshman **LaPri McCray-Pace** (Morgan State) ranks second amongst freshmen with 11.6 points followed by NCCU's **Reginald Gardner, Jr.'s** 11.2 points per game.

Surprise, Surprise

After winning four games in 2016-17, North Carolina A&T State has surpassed its output from the previous season as the Aggies are a MEAC-best 6-5 with two roads wins at Jacksonville and East Carolina.

Bethune-Cookman also has caught fire this season as the Wildcats are 5-7 overall. BCU's 4-3 record in the month of November marked the first time in program history that the Wildcats achieved four wins, and marked their winningest November ever having played at least three games.

Last year's defending champion North Carolina Central has proven that they will be a factor in league play despite heavy roster losses with five wins.

Beast

North Carolina A&T State's **Femi Olujobi** has made his presence felt in his first season on the court for the Aggies as he averages 22.1 points and nine rebounds per game. He has five double-doubles on the season.

Inside Play

Based on early returns from this year's non-conference slate, the MEAC looks to have solid inside play in addition to its consistent guard play with three players averaging eight or more rebounds. Bethune-Cookman's **Shawntrez Davis** and North Carolina A&T State's **Femi Olujobi** both average nine rebounds per contest while Morgan State's **Philip Carr** averages 8.3 boards. Davis leads the MEAC with seven double-doubles and ranks seventh nationally.

North Carolina Central's **Raasean Davis** ranks 13th nationally in field goal percentage with a 66.9 percent clip. FAMU's center **Isaiah Martin** leads the MEAC with 2.3 blocks per game and ranks 35th nationally. He ranks 12th in the NCAA with 33 blocks total.



We Can Score & Share Also

A pair of high scorers in the MEAC also have done a solid job of distributing the ball as Hampton's **Jermaine Marrow** leads the league and 18th nationally with 6.6 assists per game and 18th nationally with 6.6 assists per game followed by Howard's **R.J. Cole's** 6.4 assists per game.

Marrow ranks third in scoring with 19.1 points per game with Cole ranking second in the MEAC with 20.4 points.

In Our Prayers

South Carolina State suffered an unfortunate setback on Dec. 2 when guard **Ty Solomon** collapsed at North Carolina State. Solomon was released from the hospital several days later and visited the team the same day he was released.

2017-18 PRESEASON ALL-MEAC TEAM / PREDICTED ORDER OF FINISH

Morgan State senior forward Phillip Carr was selected as the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) Men's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year, the conference announced today. Morgan State was selected as the preseason favorite to win the MEAC this coming season.

All awards are voted on by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors.

Carr was named the 2016-17 MEAC Defensive Player of the Year and was named All-MEAC First Team. He was the MEAC's top rebounder with 9.5 rebounds per contest and ranked seventh in scoring averaging 16.6 points. Carr was also named to the BOXTOROW Division I All-America Team, the ABC All-District First Team, and the ECAC All-Star Second Team last season. He ended his junior campaign leading the league with 11 double-doubles (points and rebounds) and recorded 22 blocks and 15 steals on the season for the Bears. A two-time MEAC Player of the Week, Carr becomes the first Bear to be named the MEAC Preseason Player of the Year since Kevin Thompson before his senior season in 2010. Reggie Holmes is the last Bear to win the regular-season award, when he received the award in 2009.

Morgan State, which finished 11-5 in conference play season, picked up 13 first-place votes as this marks the first time since 2011-12 that the Bears were predicted to win the MEAC. Under the guidance of 12th year head coach Todd Bozeman, the Bears were also selected to capture first place in the MEAC during the 2008-09 and 2009-10 seasons. Norfolk State was picked to finish second, while defending MEAC regular season and postseason champions North Carolina Central was picked to finish third.

Rounding out the rest of the preseason poll are Hampton, Savannah State, Maryland Eastern Shore, S.C. State, Howard, Bethune Cookman, Delaware State, Florida A&M, Coppin State, and North Carolina A&T State.

Joining Carr on the Preseason All-MEAC First Team are Norfolk State's Zaynah Robinson, Bethune Cookman's Brandon Tabb, Howard's Charles Williams and Morgan State's Tiwian Kindley.

The 2017-18 season begins on Friday, Nov. 10 while the 2018 MEAC Basketball Tournament will be held March 5-10 at the Norfolk Scope Arena in Norfolk, Va.
