- · MEAC softball begins week two highlighted by tournaments in Savannah, Greensboro and Florida. The tournaments in Greensboro and Savannah State will be a MEAC preview as several MEAC teams will participate in games against each other.
- The Hampton Lady Pirates and the Florida A&M Lady Rattlers were predicted to win the MEAC softball Northern and Southern Divisions, respectively. Delaware State was picked to finish second behind the Lady Pirates in a tight race as they received 10 first-place votes and 153 total points. Pollsters predicted another showdown between FAMU and rival Bethune-Cookman as the Wildcats were picked second after receiving 10 first-place votes and 130 total points.
- Florida A&M, Morgan State and Bethune-Cookman captured wins in opening weekend as the Lady Rattlers defeated Georgia Tech while BCU defeated Northern Illinois and Boston. Morgan State closed out the weekend with wins over Toledo and Fairleigh Dickinson.
- Preseason Player of the Year Ryan Jackson picked up where she left off from 2017 as she hit three homers this past weekend. The sophomore hit 14 homers as a freshman
- Morgan State's **Damali Young** compiled 10 hits over the weekend to go along with three doubles and a triple.
- Preseason Pitcher of the Year **Amy Begg** also picked up where she left off from 2017 as she struck out 21 batters in four games this past weekend.
- The 2018 MEAC Tournament takes place once again in Ormond Beach, Fla. as Bethune-Cookman will host the tournament.

# MEAC Softball Weekly Honors

Bethune-Cookman's Ryan Jackson and Morgan State's Damali Young were selected as selected as the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) Co-Softball Players of the Week, the conference announced today. Florida A&M's Veronica Burse and Bethune-Cookman's Victoria Guzman shared Co-Pitchers of the Week Honors while Guzman was named Rookie of the Week.

Young (OF, 5-2, Jr., Westampton, N.J.) finished the first week of action with a .500 average (10-of-20) in six games. She currently leads the conference in hits, doubles (3) and triples (1) while drawing two walks. Young, who totaled 15 bases, scored four times last week with a pair of three-hit games versus Tennessee at Chattanooga and Fairleigh Dickinson.

Jackson (OF, 5-6, So., Chino Hills, Calif.) batted .313 over the weekend as she led the MEAC in runs (4), RBIs (4), triples (1) and total bases (16). The MEAC's leader in home runs last season (14), Jackson picked up where she left off from 2017 as she hit three homers this past weekend.

Guzman (P, 5-1, Fr., San Jose, Calif) had an impressive Bethune-Cookman debut as she posted a 1.76 ERA with a 1-1 record. She tallied 13 strikeouts and a save in five appearances over the weekend. Guzman picked up her first win in relief versus Boston University on Saturday while earning a save in Sunday's win over Northern Illinois.

Burse (P, 5-5, Sr., Atlanta, Ga.) ended the first weekend of action with a 1-1 record and eight strikeouts. Burse led the Rattlers to a win over Georgia Tech as she struck out five with only one earned run.

## Other Top Performers

**Morgan Crawford (Hampton)** recorded six hits in four games at the Gardner-Webb Tournament, highlighted by a 3-for-3 performance in the final game.

**Hera Varmah (Florida A&M)** batted .333 with two hits, two runs, two RBI and a home run in two games.

**Mackenzie Woodard (Florida A&M)** averaged .800 going 4-for-5 during a two-game span, highlighted by a perfect 3-for-3 outing in the win against Georgia Tech.



# MEAC ANNOUNCES SOFTBALL PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE HONORS

The Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) has announced that Morgan State's Amy Begg has been selected as the conference's Preseason Pitcher of the Year while Bethune-Cookman's Ryan Jackson was tabbed Preseason Player of the Year. Ten institutions were represented on the team led by Bethune-Cookman' five selections. Delaware State, Florida A&M and Maryland Eastern Shore each had three selections while Hampton, Morgan State and North Carolina A&T State had two apiece.

All preseason honors were voted on by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors.

A senior from Christchurch, New Zealand, Begg led the MEAC with 179 strikeouts and 20 wins on the mound as she posted a 2.31 ERA in 2017. A five-time MEAC Pitcher of the Week, Begg also led the league with seven shutouts and finished second in opponent batting average (.227). In her three-year career at Morgan State, Begg has amassed a total of 389 strikeouts.

Jackson was named the MEAC's Player and Rookie of the Year in 2017 as she led the MEAC in batting average (.408), home runs (14), RBIs (47), total bases (118), on-base percentage (.483) and slugging percentage (.771). A three-time MEAC Player of the Week and two-time Rookie of the Week, the Chino Hills, Calif. native was also named to the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Division I National Freshman of the Year Top 25.

The 2018 season begins on Friday, Feb. 9 with the first conference matchup scheduled for March 17. The MEAC Tournament returns to Ormond Beach, Fla. and begins on May 9.
