- · MEAC softball begins week three as preseason tournaments highlight the ledger.
- The Hampton Lady Pirates and the Florida A&M Lady Rattlers were predicted to win the MEAC softball Northern and Southern Divisions, respectively. Delaware State was picked to finish second behind the Lady Pirates in a tight race as they received 10 first-place votes and 153 total points. Pollsters predicted another showdown between FAMU and rival Bethune-Cookman as the Wildcats were picked second after receiving 10 first-place votes and 130 total points.
- Florida A&M and Bethune-Cookman both held its own in preseason tournament play last weekend as the Ratters knocked off Texas Tech of the Big 12 while Bethune-Cookman claimed three non-conference wins. Savannah State posted a 3-1 mark in its own tournament while Norfolk State came on strong at the Savannah State Classic with four wins.
- Preseason Player of the Year Ryan Jackson of Bethune-Cookman picked up where she left off from 2017 as she leads the MEAC with 15 hits, 10 RBIs and four home runs. Howard's Kamyrn Tillman follows with 11 hits.
- Norfolk State's Meaghan Barfield totaled 9-of-19 with 10 RBIs, three home runs, one double and a stolen base as Norfolk State finished the weekend with a 4-2 record. Savannah State's **Cortni Jones** batted .667 with 10 hits over the weekend also.
- Preseason Pitcher of the Year Amy Begg picked up where she left off from 2017 as she struck out 21 batters in four game on opening weekend. North Carolina Central's Courtney Mirabella leads the MEAC with 29 strikeouts in four appearances followed by 21 from Victoria Guzman of Bethune-Cookman.
- The 2018 MEAC Tournament takes place once again in Ormond Beach, Fla. as Bethune-Cookman will host the tournament.

# MEAC Softball Weekly Honors

Bethune-Cookman's Ryan Jackson and Savannah State's Cortni Jones were selected as the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) Co-Softball Players of the Week, the conference announced today. Florida A&M's Kyaira Brown and Savannah State's Amanda Hallman shared Co-Pitchers of the Week Honors while Bethune-Cookman's Alexis Bermudez was named Rookie of the Week.

Jones (3B, 5-5, Jr., Snellville, Ga.) was the MEAC's top batter after the past weekend as she finished with a .667 average while tying for the league lead in hits (10), second in home runs (2), sixth in runs scored (6), third in doubles (2), fifth in RBIs (6), second in total bases (18), first in on-base percentage (.667) and slugging percentage (1.200). Savannah State opened the season with a 3-1 record as Jones' best game was a 4-for-4 performance with a home run versus Norfolk State.

Jackson (OF, 5-6, So., Chino Hills, Calif.) batted .556 over the weekend while racking up 10 hits, five doubles, a home run and six RBIs. She also scored four runs while stealing four bases. The Wildcats finished the weekend with a 3-2 mark with wins over Stetson, Quinnipiac and Northern lowa. She batted .750 in two games over the weekend as she batted 3-for-4 with three RBIs and a double versus LIU Brooklyn. Versus Quinnipiac, Jackson also went 3-for-4 with three doubles and an RBI.

Bermudez (P, 5-6, Fr., Santa Fe Springs, Calif.) batted .429 with a team-high nine RBIs last weekend in Bethune-Cookman's five games. Against LIU Brooklyn, Bermudez batted .750 with three hits and two RBIs while also accounting for four RBIs and a homer versus Stetson. She also picked up a win on the mound against Stetson.

Brown (P, 5-7, So., Tallahassee, Fla.) struck out eight while compiling a 1.76 ERA in four appearances. She held opposing batters to a .153 average en route to picking up a big win over Texas Tech which saw her strike out four while allowing only four hits.

Hallman (P, 5-9, Sr., Kennesaw, Ga.) led the MEAC with two wins while compiling 13 strikeouts and a 0.75 ERA. Opponents finished with a .163 average against Hallman as she allowed only seven hits in three appearances.

# **Other Top Performers**

**Meaghan Barfield (Norfolk State)** totaled 9-of-19 with 10 RBIs, three home runs, one double and a stolen base as Norfolk State finished with the weekend with a 4-2 record.

Samantha Casarez (Maryland Eastern Shore) batted .636 (7-of-11) with four RBIs, two doubles, a home run and stolen hase

Nasya Goodman (Maryland Eastern Shore) struck out eight with a 2.45 ERA in three games.

**Alyssa Lavine (Howard)** finished 5-for-11 with eight RBI, three runs, two doubles, a home run and a triple.

**Skylar Swain (Norfolk State)** went 1-1 on the mound with 12 strikeouts and a 2.40 ERA. She also struck out eight while allowing one run in a win over South Carolina State.

**Kamryn Tillman (Howard)** batted .583 in four games played with her first career home run versus Maryland Eastern Shore.

# MEAC ANNOUNCES SOFTBALL PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE HONORS

The Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) has announced that Morgan State's Amy Begg has been selected as the conference's Preseason Pitcher of the Year while Bethune-Cookman's Ryan Jackson was tabbed Preseason Player of the Year. Ten institutions were represented on the team led by Bethune-Cookman' five selections. Delaware State, Florida A&M and Maryland Eastern Shore each had three selections while Hampton, Morgan State and North Carolina A&T State had two apiece.

All preseason honors were voted on by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors.

A senior from Christchurch, New Zealand, Begg led the MEAC with 179 strikeouts and 20 wins on the mound as she posted a 2.31 ERA in 2017. A five-time MEAC Pitcher of the Week, Begg also led the league with seven shutouts and finished second in opponent batting average (.227). In her three-year career at Morgan State, Begg has amassed a total of 389 strikeouts.

Jackson was named the MEAC's Player and Rookie of the Year in 2017 as she led the MEAC in batting average (.408), home runs (14), RBIs (47), total bases (118), on-base percentage (.483) and slugging percentage (.771). A three-time MEAC Player of the Week and two-time Rookie of the Week, the Chino Hills, Calif. native was also named to the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Division I National Freshman of the Year Top 25.

The 2018 season begins on Friday, Feb. 9 with the first conference matchup scheduled for March 17. The MEAC Tournament returns to Ormond Beach, Fla. and begins on May 9.
