That alone will change the dynamic of the season, as there is a possibility for constant changes throughout the year.

OPENING WEEK

• The 2020-21 MEAC men's basketball season opens up with 19 games the first week, with everything starting on Wednesday, Nov. 25, with seven games on the docket. Three more contests follow on Thanksgiving and there are five more games on Friday, Saturday, Nov. 28 will see five teams in action, including a game between Coppin State and 2019 Elite Eight participant Duke.

LAST SEASON

• The Eagles of North Carolina Central claimed their fourth MEAC regular-season title, finishing the regular season 13-3, but the story was the Aggies of North Carolina A&T under interim head coach Will Jones, who went 12-4 during the regular season. Jones earned MEAC Coach of the Year honors for the job he did taking over the Aggies. However, the story of last season came in March during the tournament when everyone around the country was hit with the COVID-19 pandemic. Due the to pandemic the NCAA basketball tournament was canceled and following that announcement the entire spring sports season was placed on canceled due to the safety of the student-athletes, coaches, spectators and all those around college athletes.

DID YOU KNOW?

THE NEW NORMAL

- With Covid-19 pandemic still front and center, teams have to get adjusted to a different routine than they may be used to as now they are required to get tested a few times a week to determine if they are healthy enough to play.

MR. MAKER

- Howard head coach Kenny Blakeney signed the biggest recruit in MEAC history in Makur Maker. Maker was listed as the No. 16 player in the ESPN 100 and the No. 4 ranked center in the 2020 recruiting class. He averaged 14.7 ppg and 7.9 rpg with the Dream Vision on the Adidas AAU circuit.
- Maker picked Howard over UCLA and Kentucky and became the first 5-star recruit to commit to an HBCU since ESPN started ranking prospects in 2007.

KAMERON LANGLEY

- The senior from High Point, N.C. is the MEAC's all-time leader in assists with 632 total assists...a total that he will look to keep adding to as the season progress on this year.
- in 2019, he lead the nation in assists per game (8.0), total assists (247) and triple doubles with two last season. Langley will look to get the most of his final season as he continues to set the new mark assists in the MEAC.

2020-21 PRESEASON ALL-MEAC TEAM / PREDICTED ORDER OF FINISH

North Carolina A&T State University senior guard Kameron Langley was named the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) Men's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year, presented by TowneBank. Norfolk State was selected as the preseason favorite to win the MEAC's Northern Division, while North Carolina Central was tabbed to win the MEAC's Southern Division.

All awards were voted on by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors.

Langley, who earned First Team All-MEAC honors, led the nation in assists per game (8.0), total assists (247) and triple-doubles (2) last season. He set the school and MEAC's all-time assists records and continues to set the standard. He had 12 games with 10 or more assists, including a MEAC Tournament-record 15 against Howard on March 11. He led the MEAC in assist/turnover ratio (2.4) and finished second in the MEAC in steals per game (2.1).

Additionally, the two-time MEAC Player of the Week averaged 9.4 points per games on 44 percent shooting in 2019-20.

Norfolk State picked up 16 first-place votes, as the Spartans were selected to win the Northern Division. The Spartans finished last season tied

for second with a 12-4 record in MEAC play while going 16-15 overall.

Morgan State was picked to finish second, followed by the Howard Bison, who made a splash in the offseason with the addition of preseason first team honoree Makur Maker. Coppin State was picked to finish third, while Delaware State and Maryland Eastern Shore rounded out the division.

For the Southern Division, North Carolina Central captured its fourth MEAC regular-season title last season under head coach LeVelle Moton. Moton and the Eagles finished 13-3 in MEAC play and 18-13 overall as they were selected to finish atop of the Southern division.

North Carolina A&T State was picked second after finishing with a 12-4 conference record last season, followed by the Florida A&M Aggies. Rounding out the rest of the preseason poll for the Southern Division are Bethune-Cookman and South Carolina State.

Joining Langley on the Preseason All-MEAC First Team are Coppin State's DeJuan Clayton and Koby Thomas, North Carolina Central's C.J. Keyser and Howard's Maker.
