Located in Norfolk, Va., the MEAC is made up of 11 outstanding historically black institutions across the Atlantic coastline: Bethune-Cookman University, Coppin State University, Delaware State University, Florida A&M University, Howard University, University of Maryland Eastern Shore, Morgan State University, Norfolk State University, North Carolina A&T State University, North Carolina Central University and South Carolina State University.

The MEAC sponsors 15 Division I (FCS) sports with automatic qualifying bids for NCAA postseason competition in baseball, bowling, men's and women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, men's and women's tennis, men's and women's track and field, softball, volleyball and men's golf.

The MEAC will name first, second and third all-conference teams, players of the year on offense, defense and special teams, rookie of the year, offensive lineman of the year and coach of the year.

The awards will be announced Nov. 25, 2019 with the league's offensive and defensive players of the year named on Dec. 10 as part of the festivities surrounding the 62nd NFF Annual Awards Dinner at the Hilton Midtown in New York City.

The MEAC All-Academic Team is comprised of players who have an overall grade-point average of 3.0 or better over the previous academic year. The team will be announced on Nov. 14.

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SEASON NOTES

COLLEGE FOOTBALL TURNS 150

The Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference begins its 49th season of college football in 2019. College football is one of the most popular sports in the USA. Four college football stadiums, Penn State's Beaver Stadium, Michigan's Michigan Stadium, Ohio State's Ohio Stadium and Tennessee's Neyland Stadium hold more than 100,000 fans and their games are almost always sell outs. Even high school football games in some areas draw more than 10,000 fans.



The birth of football in the United States goes back to Nov. 6, 1869, when teams from Princeton and Rutgers universities met in New Brunswick, New Jersey, for the first intercollegiate football game. In the early games, each team was allowed 25 players. By 1873, this number had been reduced to 20, in 1876 it was reduced again to 15, and in 1880 to the present day number of 11.

Over the years, many changes have been made to the game. The playing field itself has been reduced in length from 120 yards, exclusive of end zones, to the present 100 yards, and in width from 100 yards, to the current 53-1/3 yards.

The first ball used was round, then became an oval shape 23 inches around the middle, and now is 20 3/4 -21 1/4 inches around the middle. Originally a touchdown was counted as two points and a field goal was five points. In the present day game, a touchdown is worth six points and a field goal three points. Changes in the rules have been made to maintain a balance between the offense and defense and to foster the safety of the players.

By 1906, the game was extremely rough and many injuries and some deaths had occurred. Educators considered dropping the sport despite its popularity on campuses. President Theodore Roosevelt, an ardent advocate of strenuous sports, declared that it must be made safer. As a result, football leaders revamped the game and many of the rougher tactics were outlawed.

One of the major changes to the rules was the legalizing of the forward pass. It was hoped, and this hope was proven correct, that by opening up the game fewer players would be injured in the mass rushing plays that were so popular and effective at the turn of the century. The rules committee also changed the downs system, requiring a team to make 10 yards, not five, in three tries for a first down. In 1912, the rule was changed to four tries, or downs, to make a first down.

After World War II, college football players began to receive athletics scholarships in such increasing numbers that today nearly every major college football player is paid room, board, tuition and other expenses, usually from donations from alumni and game profits. At the same time, the quality of the game has improved. Nearly all major college football teams are members of either the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) or the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA), which implement the rules and oversee competition between teams.

MEAC OVERVIEW

The 2019 MEAC football schedule is comprised of 69 total games, including 36 conference contests, 33 non-conference games and a minimum of one postseason contest (Celebration Bowl).

The 2019 schedule will play out over 13 weeks with the conference schedule concluding on Nov. 23. The 2019 MEAC champion is scheduled to play on national television in the Celebration Bowl on Dec. 21 in Atlanta, Ga.

Five teams on the 2019 MEAC schedule participated in 2018-19 postseason bowl games. Six of the MEAC's 18 games scheduled against Football Championship Subdivision teams were 2018 FCS Playoff participants.

The MEAC schedule also features nine games versus Football Bowl Subdivision teams, with the first occurring on Aug. 29 and the finale' on Sept. 21.

NEW HEAD COACHES IN THE MEAC

After welcoming five new head coaches to the MEAC last year, there are three new faces walking the sideline this year as the 2019 season continues.

Ron Prince is the new man at Howard following the departure of Mike London to The College of William & Mary. Prince is the only one of the new coaches with head coaching experience, after serving as head coach at Kansas State from 2006-08. Prince joins the Bison after being at Michigan last season.

Former Michigan standout athlete and Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year Tyrone Wheatley is leading the Morgan State Bears in his first time as a college

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head coach. Wheatley comes to the Bears after coaching running backs with the Jacksonville Jaguars.

Trei Oliver became the third football coach in the MEAC to become head coach at his alma mater, joining Rod Milstead (Delaware State) and Buddy Pough (South Carolina State) when he was hired by North Carolina Central on Dec. 13, 2018. This is Oliver's first head coaching position and he comes back home after spending the last three seasons as defensive coordinator at Southern University.

MEAC DIGITAL NETWORK ON ESPN

As part of a multi-year agreement reached last year, the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) and ESPN will stream all of the conference's football contests on ESPN3 and ESPN+, the multi-sport, direct-to-consumer subscription streaming service from The Walt Disney Company Direct-to-Consumer & International segment and ESPN.

There will be 34 MEAC football contests available on ESPN3 and ESPN+ this season, in addition to 10 televised contests on either ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 or ESPNU, which gives the conference

44 total linear and digital broadcasts across the ESPN family of networks.

MEAC TO IMPLEMENT INSTANT REPLAY

This season, the MEAC will implement instant replay for all football games, starting with the first conference game of the 2019 season, which will be Saturday, Sept. 21, when Howard visits Delaware State. The following Saturday, Sept. 28, will be the first full weekend of conference play.

Each institution has the option to utilize the instant replay during non-conference games as well.

THE CELEBRATION BOWL

For the fifth consecutive season, the MEAC champion will participate in the Air Force Reserve Celebration Bowl against the champion from the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC). Last year, North Carolina A&T State defeated Alcorn State 24-22.

The 2019 Celebration Bowl will be televised live on ABC to open up the college football bowl season and played at the Mercedes-Benz Stadium in Atlanta, Ga. on Saturday, December 21. The all-time bowl series is at 3-1, as North Carolina A&T State leads the

MEAC with three appearances.

FCS PLAYOFFS

With the participation of the MEAC champion in the Celebration Bowl, the conference does not have an automatic bid to the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) playoffs. However, the league still has an opportunity to earn an at-large bid.

North Carolina A&T State earned an at-large bid in 2016 as it marked the first time since South Carolina State earned a bid in 2013, as both them and Bethune-Cookman participated in the playoffs that season.

The last FCS playoff win for the MEAC occurred in 1999 as Florida A&M defeated Appalachian State (44-29) and Troy State (17-10) en route to a semifinal appearance against Youngstown State (L, 41-3), who lost to Georgia Southern in the Championship game. North Carolina A&T State won its opening round contest against Tennessee State, 27-24 in the same year.

NORTH CAROLINA/FLORIDA PRIDE

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from those states have claimed a MEAC Championship since 2012. Bethune-Cookman (Florida) has won an outright or a share of the title in 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015, while North Carolina A&T State and North Carolina Central has have won outright or a share of the title in 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018.

If the predicted order of finish is any indication then the trend will remain the same as North Carolina A&T State was picked to finish first, while Bethune-Cookman and Florida A&M were selected to finish second and third with North Carolina Central not far behind, selected to finish fifth.

MEAC IN THE RANKINGS

After being ranked for the first time since 2009, Florida A&M continues to rise in the rankings. They are 14th in the AFCA Coaches Poll and 12th in the STATS FCS rankings.

After the loss to Morgan State, North Carolina A&T is 25th in the STATS FCS rankings and the AFCA Coaches Poll.

The Rattlers continue to hold the No. 1 spot in the BOXTOROW Coaches Poll.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Offensive Player of the Week:

De'Montrez Burroughs, WR, SC State

- Senior receiver De'Montrez Burroughs was named MEAC Offensive Player of the Week for his play in the Bulldogs' 62-21 blowout win over Howard. Burroughs caught seven passes for 140 yards and a school-record five touchdowns.

Defensive Player of the Week:

Ian McBorrough, LB, Morgan State

- Senior linebacker Ian McBorrough was named the MEAC Defensive Player

of the Week for his performance in the Bears' 22-16 upset win over North Carolina A&T. McBorrough helped the Bears limit the No. 14 Aggies below their league-leading 34.5 points per game to just 16 points. He paced the defense with 12 tackles (2.5 TFL) as the Aggies posted their second straight upset of a ranked Aggies team.

Offensive Lineman of the Week:

Alex Taylor, OL, South Carolina State

- Redshirt senior offensive lineman Alex Taylor was named the MEAC Offensive Lineman of the Week for his performance in the Bulldogs' 62-21 win over Howard. Taylor graded out at 98% and helped pave the way for the Bulldogs' offense to rack up 462 yards of total offense (347 yards through the air and 115 yards on the ground). He helped Corey Fields throw a school-record seven touchdown passes. He had four pancake blocks and didn't surrender any sacks.

Rookie of the Week:

Corey Fields, QB, South Carolina State

- Freshman quarterback Corey Fields was named the MEAC Rookie of the Week for his performance in the Bulldogs' 62-21 win over Howard. Fields had a career day, completing 18-of-29 passes for 333 yards and a program record seven touchdowns. He tied Florida A&M's Pat Bonner for second in MEAC history with seven touchdowns.

Specialist of the Week:

Cliff Benjamin, P, South Carolina State

- Graduate punter Cliff Benjamin, Jr. was named MEAC Specialist of the Week for his play in the Bulldogs' 62-21 win over Howard. Benjamin punted three times for 132 yards. He averaged 44 yards per punt with a long of 51 yards. He pinned three punts inside the 20.

WINNINGEST COACH

South Carolina State head coach Buddy Pough made history with a 24-10 win over Morgan State on Homecoming on Oct. 19, 2019. Pough won his 129th game to become the winningest coach in Bulldogs' history. He passed his coach, Hall of Famer Willie Jeffries, for

the school record.

"This is a surreal moment at this point in my career," said Pough. "To reach a milestone of this magnitude is an awesome feeling and I am glad I had a chance to share it with my family and friends. Thank you to all the people that played a role in me reaching this accomplishment from the fans, alumni, faculty and administration."

MEAC FOOTBALL RACE HEATS UP

North Carolina A&T State and Bethune-Cookman each control their own destiny as it relates to the road to the Celebration Bowl. Both teams sit atop the MEAC standings at 4-1, and this weekend, the Aggies will North Carolina A&T State and Bethune-Cookman play each other on this Saturday live on ESPN3 in a game that will be rebroadcast on ESPNU at 10:30 pm that night.

JERRY RICE WATCH LIST

Norfolk State running back Kevin Johnson was named to the watch list for the Jerry Rice Award, given annually to the top freshman at the Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) level. Johnson is currently tied for third in the MEAC with nine total touchdowns, six rushing and three receiving. He also ranks fourth in the MEAC in all-purpose yards (105.4 ypg) and seventh in rushing yards (49.1 ypg).

WALTER PAYTON WATCH LIST

Florida A&M quarterback Ryan Stanley and North Carolina A&T State running back Jah-Main Martin have been added to the Watch List for the Walter Payton Award, known by many as the Heisman of FCS. Stanley is rewriting FAMU's record books as he has led the Rattlers to eight straight wins, while Martin is the nation's top rusher at the FCS level, averaging nearly 127 yards a game on the ground. His 16 rushing touchdowns are by far the most in the conference.

ALL-TIME PASSING LEADER

Ryan Stanley continues to rewrite the Rattlers' record books. After throwing for 253 yards and four scores in the win

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over Delaware State, Stanley continues to add to his record as he has now thrown for 8,252 yards during his time in Tallahassee, which is already the school record. The four touchdowns by Stanley gave him 60 for his career to break Quinn Gray's school record and his 25 passing attempts matched Gray's record. He also continues to build on the completions record with 675. Stanley is second in MEAC history in passing yards behind Howard's Ted White (9,200). He's fourth in MEAC history in passing touchdowns (60) and has a chance to break into the top ten in single-season passing touchdowns in MEAC history...he currently has 19 on the season.

ALL-TIME LEADING RECEIVER

Howard senior wide receiver Kyle Anthony continues to add to the Howard receiving legacy as he is currently the school's all-time leader in receptions, passing former Howard great and Anthony's former head coach Gary "Flea" Harrell. After catching six passes against South Carolina State, Anthony now has 193 for his career, which ranks sixth in MEAC history.

FRESHMAN REWRITES RECORD BOOKS

South Carolina State has been operating with a two quarterback system all year, but freshman quarterback Corey Fields might have ended that debate in the Bulldogs' 62-21 win over Howard. Fields was named the MEAC Rookie of the Week for his play in the win. Fields had a career day, completing 18-of-29 passes for 333 yards and a program record seven touchdowns. He tied FAMU's Pat Bonner for second in MEAC history with seven touchdowns in a single game. Howard's Ted White holds the record with eight. Bonner and White reached their marks in the same game in 1993. He was also named the STATS FCS Freshman of the Week.

LEADING RUSHER IN THE COUNTRY

North Carolina A&T State running back Jah-Maine Martin has been the next great back out of "Running Back U". Despite running for just 80 yards and a touchdown on 16 carries against

Morgan State, Martin is approaching 1,100 rushing yards on the season. It marks the seventh straight season, and the ninth time in ten years that the Aggies have had a thousand-yard rusher. Through nine games, Martin has 141 carries for 1,094 yards and 16 touchdowns. He's averaging 7.8 yards per carry and 121.6 yards per game. He has a 200-yard game and a three 100 yard games this season. Martin leads the country in yards per carry, is second in rushing yards per game, fourth in scoring, and is fifth in total touchdowns.

ELIJAH CUMMINGS TRIBUTE

Throughout the 2019-20 season, the Morgan State Bears student-athletes will celebrate the life of longtime Baltimore Congressman Elijah Cummings, who passed away on October 17, 2019, at the age of 68. In honor of Congressman Cummings and all of his many positive contributions to the University and his district, all Morgan State athletic teams will wear a special commemorative "EC" patch on their jerseys throughout the season. The Bears football team helmets will also be adorned with an EC decal. "Our department wanted to do something to recognize the many important contributions of the Honorable Elijah Cummings to the country, the City of Baltimore, and Morgan State University," said Director of Athletics Edward Scott, Ph.D. "In speaking with our student athletes, coaches, and staff, we felt that the patches and decals would be the most appropriate way of demonstrating our appreciation to Regent Cummings and his family.

NATIONAL LEADERS

In addition to Martin, several other MEAC players and teams are nationally ranked in respective categories. Keenan Black (Delaware State), Jayden Brunson (South Carolina State), Manassah Bailey (Morgan State) and Deondre Daniels (South Carolina State) are all tied for second in punt return touchdowns. Noel Ruiz (North Carolina A&T) is first in field goals per game and fifth in field goal percentage. Corey Fields (South Carolina State) is second

in passing yards per completion. Chris Faddoul (Florida A&M) is fifth in punting. De'Montrez Burroughs is fifth in receiving touchdowns. Xavier Smith (Florida A&M) is second in receiving yards per game and fifth in receptions per game. North Carolina A&T is fourth in the country in terms of fourth down conversion percentage and is also fourth in rushing defense. South Carolina State is second in the country in blocked kicks and blocked punts. The Bulldogs also are second in team tackles for a loss. Bethune-Cookman is fourth in blocked kicks, kick return defense, and kickoff returns. The Wildcats are third in red zone defense. North Carolina Central is tied for sixth in the country in interceptions and takeaways.

MILESTONES

- Delaware State's Thomas Bertrand-Hudon ran for a career-high 133 yards and a touchdown against Bethune-Cookman on Saturday. He became the first Hornet with back to back 100-yard rushing games since Jaashawn Jones did it against North Carolina A&T (144) and Morgan State (114) in 2010.
- Delaware State snapped a six game losing streak to Bethune-Cookman, dating back to 2008.
- Morgan State's Manasseh Bailey had seven catches for 118 yards and a touchdown. He's now tied for fifth place on the Bears' all-time receiving list with 1,802 yards.
- South Carolina State's De'Montrez Burroughs had a program record five touchdown catches in the win over Howard.
