Located in Norfolk, Va., the MEAC is made up of 11 outstanding historically black institutions across the Atlantic coastline: Bethune-Cookman University, Coppin State University, Delaware State University, Florida A&M University, Howard University, University of Maryland Eastern Shore, Morgan State University, Norfolk State University, North Carolina A&T State University, North Carolina Central University and South Carolina State University.

The MEAC sponsors 15 Division I (FCS) sports with automatic qualifying bids for NCAA postseason competition in baseball, bowling, men's and women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, men's and women's tennis, men's and women's track and field, softball, volleyball and men's golf.

SEASON NOTES

COLLEGE FOOTBALL TURNS 150

The Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference begins its 49th season of college football in 2019. College football is one of the most popular sports in the USA. Four college football stadiums, Penn State's Beaver Stadium, Michigan's Michigan Stadium, Ohio State's Ohio Stadium and Tennessee's Neyland Stadium hold more than 100,000 fans and their games are almost always sell outs. Even high school football games in some areas draw more than 10,000 fans.



The birth of football in the United States goes back to Nov. 6, 1869, when teams from Princeton and Rutgers universities met in New Brunswick, New Jersey, for the first intercollegiate football game. In the early games, each team was allowed 25 players. By 1873, this number had been reduced to 20, in 1876 it was reduced again to 15, and in 1880 to the present day number of 11.

Over the years, many changes have been made to the game. The playing field itself has been reduced in length from 120 yards, exclusive of end zones, to the present 100 yards, and in width from 100 yards, to the current 53-1/3 yards.

The first ball used was round, then became an oval shape 23 inches around the middle, and now is 20 3/4 -21 1/4 inches around the middle. Originally a touchdown was counted as two points and a field goal was five points. In the present day game, a touchdown is worth six points and a field goal three points. Changes in the rules have been made to maintain a balance between the offense and defense and to foster the safety of the players.

By 1906, the game was extremely rough and many injuries and some deaths had occurred. Educators considered dropping the sport despite its popularity on campuses. President Theodore Roosevelt, an ardent advocate of strenuous sports, declared that it must be made safer. As a result, football leaders revamped the game and many of the rougher tactics were outlawed.

One of the major changes to the rules was the legalizing of the forward pass. It was hoped, and this hope was proven correct, that by opening up the game fewer players would be injured in the mass rushing plays that were so popular and effective at the turn of the century. The rules committee also changed the downs system, requiring a team to make 10 yards, not five, in three tries for a first down. In 1912, the rule was changed to four tries, or downs, to make a first down.

After World War II, college football players began to receive athletics scholarships in such increasing numbers that today nearly every major college football player is paid room, board, tuition and other expenses, usually from donations from alumni and game profits. At the same time, the quality of the game has improved. Nearly all major college football teams are members of either the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) or the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA), which implement the rules and oversee competition between teams.

MEAC OVERVIEW

The 2019 MEAC football schedule is comprised of 69 total games, including 36 conference contests, 33 non-conference games and a minimum of one postseason contest (Celebration Bowl).

The 2019 schedule will play out over 13 weeks with the conference schedule concluding on Nov. 23. The 2019 MEAC champion is scheduled to play on national television in the Celebration Bowl on Dec. 21 in Atlanta, Ga.

Five teams on the 2019 MEAC schedule participated in 2018-19 postseason bowl games. Six of the MEAC's 18 games scheduled against Football Championship Subdivision teams were 2018 FCS Playoff participants.

The MEAC schedule also features nine games versus Football Bowl Subdivision teams, with the first occurring on Aug. 29 and the finale' on Sept. 21.

NEW HEAD COACHES IN THE MEAC

After welcoming five new head coaches to the MEAC last year, there are three new faces walking the sideline this year as the 2019 season continues.

Ron Prince is the new man at Howard following the departure of Mike London to The College of William & Mary. Prince is the only one of the new coaches with head coaching experience, after serving as head coach at Kansas State from 2006-08. Prince joins the Bison after being at Michigan last season.

Former Michigan standout athlete and Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year Tyrone Wheatley is leading the Morgan State Bears in his first time as a college head coach. Wheatley comes to the Bears after coaching running backs with the Jacksonville Jaguars.

Trei Oliver became the third football coach in the MEAC to become head coach at his alma mater, joining Rod

Milstead (Delaware State) and Buddy Pough (South Carolina State) when he was hired by North Carolina Central on Dec. 13, 2018. This is Oliver's first head coaching position and he comes back home after spending the last three seasons as defensive coordinator at Southern University.

MEAC DIGITAL NETWORK ON ESPN

As part of a multi-year agreement reached last year, the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) and ESPN will stream all of the conference's football contests on ESPN3 and ESPN+, the multi-sport, direct-to-consumer subscription streaming service from The Walt Disney Company Direct-to-Consumer & International segment and ESPN.

There will be 34 MEAC football contests available on ESPN3 and ESPN+ this season, in addition to 10 televised contests on either ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 or ESPNU, which gives the conference 44 total linear and digital broadcasts across the ESPN family of networks.

MEAC TO IMPLEMENT INSTANT REPLAY

This season, the MEAC will implement instant replay for all football games, starting with the first conference game

of the 2019 season, which will be Saturday, Sept. 21, when Howard visits Delaware State. The following Saturday, Sept. 28, will be the first full weekend of conference play.

Each institution has the option to utilize the instant replay during non-conference games as well.

THE CELEBRATION BOWL

For the fifth consecutive season, the MEAC champion will participate in the Celebration Bowl against the champion from the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC). Last year, North Carolina A&T State defeated Alcorn State 24-22.

The 2019 Celebration Bowl will be televised live on ABC to open up the college football bowl season and played at the Mercedes-Benz Stadium in Atlanta, Ga. on Saturday, December 21. The all-time bowl series is at 3-1, as North Carolina A&T State leads the MEAC with three appearances.

FCS PLAYOFFS

With the participation of the MEAC champion in the Celebration Bowl, the conference does not have an automatic bid to the Football Championship

Subdivision (FCS) playoffs. However, the league still has an opportunity to earn an at-large bid.

North Carolina A&T State earned an at-large bid in 2016 as it marked the first time since South Carolina State earned a bid in 2013, as both them and Bethune-Cookman participated in the playoffs that season.

The last FCS playoff win for the MEAC occurred in 1999, when Florida A&M defeated Appalachian State (44-29) and Troy State (17-10) en route to a semifinal appearance against Youngstown State (L, 41-3), who lost to Georgia Southern in the Championship game. North Carolina A&T State won its opening round contest against Tennessee State, 27-24 in the same year.

MEAC IN THE RANKINGS

After being ranked for the first time since 2009, Florida A&M continues to rise in the rankings. They are 13th in the AFCA Coaches Poll and 12th in the STATS FCS rankings following a home win over Howard.

After a win over Bethune-Cookman, North Carolina A&T is now 25th in the STATS FCS rankings and 24th in the

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Co-Offensive Player of the Week:

Manasseh Bailey, WR, Morgan State

• Senior receiver Manasseh Bailey was named MEAC Co-Offensive Player of the Week for his play in the Bears' 59-26 win over Virginia University of Lynchburg. Bailey caught five passes for a game high 177 yards and four touchdowns, including an 87-yard touchdown reception. He ran back two kickoffs for 22 yards.

Jah-Maine Martin, RB, NC A&T State

• Junior running back Jah-Maine Martin was named MEAC Co-Offensive Player of the Week for his play in the Aggies' 47-17 win over Bethune-Cookman. Martin ran for 120 yards and three scores on 19 carries. The three touchdowns gave him 19 for the season, which breaks the Aggies' single season record and ties the school record for total touchdowns. It was his fifth 100-yard game of the season.

Defensive Player of the Week:

Bobby Price, DB, Norfolk State

• Senior defensive back Bobby Price was named the MEAC Defensive Player of the Week for his performance in the Spartans' 33-17 win over Delaware State. Price logged six tackles, including three solo, and had an 84-yard pick-six in the third quarter.

Offensive Lineman of the Week:

Alex Taylor, OL, South Carolina State

• Redshirt senior offensive lineman Alex Taylor was named the MEAC Offensive Lineman of the Week for the fifth time this season for his performance in the Bulldogs' win over North Carolina Central. Taylor graded out at 95% and helped pave the way for the Bulldogs' offense to rack up 250 yards of total offense (42 yards through the air and 208 yards on the ground). He had four pancake blocks and didn't surrender any sacks.

Rookie of the Week:

Thomas Bertrand-Hudon, RB, DSU

• Freshman running back Thomas Bertrand-Hudon was named the MEAC Rookie of the Week for his performance in the Hornets' game against Norfolk State. Hudon ran for a career-high 137 yards and had a 48-yard touchdown run. He averaged 5.5 yards per carry. He became the first Hornet since Emmanuel Marc in 2006 to run for 100 yards or more in three consecutive games.

Specialist of the Week:

Cliff Benjamin, P, South Carolina State

• Graduate punter Cliff Benjamin, Jr. was named MEAC Specialist of the Week for his play in the Bulldogs' win over North Carolina Central. Benjamin punted nine times for 337 yards. He averaged 37.4 yards per punt with a long of 58 yards. He downed four punts inside the 20 and had two touchbacks.

WINNINGEST COACH

South Carolina State head coach Buddy Pough made history with a 24-10 win over Morgan State on Homecoming on Oct. 19, 2019. Pough won his 129th game to become the winningest coach in Bulldogs' history. He passed his coach, Hall of Famer Willie Jeffries, for the school record.

"This is a surreal moment at this point in my career," said Pough. "To reach a milestone of this magnitude is an awesome feeling and I am glad I had a chance to share it with my family and friends. Thank you to all the people that played a role in me reaching this accomplishment from the fans, alumni, faculty and administration."

JERRY RICE WATCH LIST

Norfolk State running back Kevin Johnson was named to the watch list for the Jerry Rice Award, given annually to the top freshman at the Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) level. Johnson is currently tied for third in the MEAC with nine total touchdowns, six rushing and three receiving. He also ranks fourth in the MEAC in all-purpose yards (105.4 ypg)

and seventh in rushing yards (49.1 ypg).

WALTER PAYTON WATCH LIST

Florida A&M quarterback Ryan Stanley and North Carolina A&T State running back Jah-Maine Martin have been added to the Watch List for the Walter Payton Award, known by many as the Heisman of FCS. Stanley is rewriting FAMU's record books as he has led the Rattlers to eight straight wins, while Martin is the nation's top rusher at the FCS level, averaging nearly 127 yards a game on the ground. His 16 rushing touchdowns are by far the most in the conference.

ALL-TIME PASSING LEADER

Ryan Stanley continues to rewrite the Rattlers' record books. After throwing for 172 yards and a touchdown in the win over Howard, Stanley continues to add to his record as he has now thrown for 8,424 yards during his time in Tallahassee, which is the school record. The touchdown by Stanley gave him 61 for his career. He is second in MEAC history in passing yards behind Howard's Ted White (9,808). He's third in MEAC history in passing touchdowns and has a chance to break into the top ten in single-season passing touchdowns in MEAC history.

ALL-TIME LEADING RECEIVER

Howard receiver Kyle Anthony continues to add to his school record for receptions. After catching eight passes for 45 yards, Anthony has 201 career receptions. He is currently tied with Delaware State's Shaheer McBride for sixth all-time in MEAC history. He will have a chance to break into the top five in his final game this weekend.

FLORIDA CLASSIC

Longtime Florida rivals Bethune-Cookman and Florida A&M will wrap up their season with the 39th annual Florida Classic at Camping World Stadium in Orlando, Fla. The Wildcats have won the last eight meetings, dating back to 2011. The Wildcats won the meeting last season, 33-19. However, the Rattlers leads the all-time series, 48-23-1.

SEASON NOTES

AGGIE-EAGLE FOOTBALL CLASSIC

State bragging rights will be on the line as longtime rivals North Carolina A&T and North Carolina Central wrap up their season by participating in the Aggie-Eagle Football Classic. The Aggies have won the last two meetings, including 45-0 last season. The Aggies lead the all-time series 51-34-5 between the two biggest HBCUs in the state, which are separated by just 54 miles on I-40. There will be some added emotion to this year's matchup. Aggies' coach Sam Washington recruited and coached Eagles' coach Trei Oliver at North Carolina Central. The two also coached together at Grambling State and North Carolina A&T.

LEADING RUSHER IN THE COUNTRY

North Carolina A&T running back Jah-Maine Martin has been the next great back out of "Running Back U." Martin was named MEAC Co-Offensive Player of the Week for his play in the Aggies' 47-17 win over Bethune-Cookman. Martin ran for 120 yards and three scores on 19 carries. The three touchdowns gave him 19 for the season, which breaks the Aggies' single season record and ties the school record for total touchdowns. It was fifth 100-yard game of the season. Through ten games, Martin has 141 carries for 1,214 yards. He's averaging 7.6 yards per carry and 121.4 yards per game. It marks the seventh straight season, and the ninth time in ten years that the Aggies have had a thousand-yard rusher. Martin leads the country in yards per carry. He's third in the country in yards per game, rushing touchdowns, scoring, total touchdowns and sixth in rushing yards.

ELIJAH CUMMINGS TRIBUTE

Throughout the 2019-20 season, the Morgan State Bears student-athletes will celebrate the life of longtime Baltimore Congressman Elijah Cummings, who passed away on October 17, 2019, at the age of 68. In honor of Congressman Cummings and all of his many positive contributions to the University and his district, all Morgan State athletic teams will wear a special commemorative "EC" patch on their jerseys throughout

the season. The Bears football team helmets will also be adorned with an EC decal. "Our department wanted to do something to recognize the many important contributions of the Honorable Elijah Cummings to the country, the City of Baltimore, and Morgan State University," said Director of Athletics Edward Scott, Ph.D. "In speaking with our student athletes, coaches, and staff, we felt that the patches and decals would be the most appropriate way of demonstrating our appreciation to Regent Cummings and his family.

NATIONAL LEADERS

In addition to Martin, several other MEAC players and teams are nationally ranked in respective categories. Keenan Black (Delaware State), Jayden Brunson (South Carolina State), Manassah Bailey (Morgan State) and Deondre Daniels (South Carolina State) are all tied for second in punt return touchdowns. Bailey is also tied for first in receiving touchdowns and fifth in receiving yards. Noel Ruiz (North Carolina A&T) is first in field goals per game and fourth in field goal percentage. Chris Faddoul (Florida A&M) is second in punting. Corey Fields (South Carolina State) and Deandre Harris (Morgan State) is second in passing yards per completion. De'Montrez Burroughs is third in receiving touchdowns. Xavier Smith (Florida A&M) is third in receiving yards per game and fifth in receptions per game. Joseph Stuckey (North Carolina A&T) is second in fumbles recovered. Jimmie Robinson (Bethune-Cookman) is fourth in kickoff returns. North Carolina A&T is third in the country in terms of fourth down conversion percentage and is fifth in rushing defense. South Carolina State is second in the country in blocked kicks, blocked punts, and team tackles for a loss. Bethune-Cookman is third in red zone defense and tied for fourth in blocked kicks. Morgan State is tied for fourth in blocked kicks. Florida A&M, North Carolina Central, and South Carolina State are tied for tenth in the country in interceptions.

MILESTONES

- Delaware State's Thomas Bertrand-Hudon ran for a career-high 137 yards and had a 48-yard touchdown run. He became the first Hornet since Emmanuel Marc in 2006 to run for 100 yards or more in three consecutive games.
- Florida A&M finished unbeaten at home and had nine wins for the first time since 2009.
- Florida A&M coach Willie Simmons now joins Rattler legends Rudy Hubbard (9-2 in 1975) and Billy Joe (9-3 in 1995) in reaching nine wins in their second season as head coach.
- Florida A&M won its ninth straight game, which is the second longest in program history since the 1998 team won 10 straight.
- Florida A&M's Xavier Smith broke the 1,000-yard mark in receiving yards with a third quarter reception. He also moved into third place in FAMU history with his 11th touchdown catch.
- Morgan State scored more than 50 points for the first time since 2011, when the Bears defeated North Carolina Central, 52-3.
- Morgan State's Deandre Harris became the first Bears quarterback to throw five touchdowns in a game since Moses Skillon accomplished the feat against Delaware State in 2014.
- Morgan State's Manasseh Bailey became the program leader for touchdown receptions in a season (10). He also had his fifth 100-yard receiving game of the season.
- Norfolk State has won three straight games for the first time since 2011.
- Norfolk State's five wins are the most since 2011.
- Norfolk State's 330 points in a season are a new D-I record, again eclipsing the 2011 team.
- Norfolk State has scored a defensive touchdown in three straight games.
- North Carolina Central's Darius Royster logged his conference leading ninth sack of the season.
- North Carolina Central's John Pecaro's 70-yard punt was the ninth longest in school history.
- South Carolina State's LaBron Morris had a career-high 135 rushing yards and a pair of scores.
