NOTES

• MEAC softball begins week 13 as the race for the MEAC Tournament is still up for grabs in the Northern Division while the Southern Division seeds are set.

• Morgan State has clinched the MEAC's Northern Division and earns the top seed out of the division in next week's conference championships. The Lady Bears will open up against No. 4 North Carolina Central. Outside of Morgan State, seeds 2-4 are undecided in the north as Delaware State, Coppin State, Hampton and Norfolk State are battling for the final three seeds. Bethune-Cookman, Florida A&M, Savannah State and North Carolina Central are seeds 1-4 in the south, respectively with Bethune-Cookman winning the division for the first time since 2014 after pulling off the series sweep over Florida A&M.

• With four teams (Delaware State, Coppin State, Hampton and Norfolk State) battling for three seeds out of the north, several scenarios can unfold based on the results of the Coppin State/Howard make-up contest this week and the Hampton/Delaware State series this weekend. See page three for the scenarios.

• Morgan State's **Damali Young** leads the MEAC with a .421 average, 61 hits and 44 runs. North Carolina Central's **Ava Dolan** ranks second with a .420 average while compiling 47 hits, 37 RBI and 24 runs. **DaSha Hill** of Hampton is third with a .409 average while also accounting for 52 hits and is 41-of-44 in stolen bases. Bethune-Cookman's **Ryan Jackson** leads the MEAC with 51 runs scored, 50 RBIs while adding 56 hits and 17 home runs.

• **Courtney Mirabella** of North Carolina Central is obliterating opposing batters with 274 strikeouts followed by Coppin State's **Madi-son Didion** (156) and Florida A&M's **Kyaira Brown** (121). Mirabella is tied with Morgan State's **Amy Begg** with 15 wins on the mound.

• The 2018 MEAC Tournament takes place once again in Ormond Beach, Fla. as Bethune-Cookman will host the tournament. The top four teams from each division make the conference tournament.

MEAC Championships Scenarios

Coppin State, Delaware State, Hampton and Norfolk State are battling for the final three spots in next week's MEAC Championships in Ormond Beach, Fla.

Multiple-Team Tie

If a multiple-team tie exists, the following shall be used to determine the seeding for the championships:

- (a) Team with the best winning percentage vs. all tied teams. Once the top team is selected the remaining teams are based on their record amongst the original tied teams;
- (b) Conference-only record based on winning percentage vs. highest ranked team in conference standings, continuing down in descending order;
- (c) Fewest runs allowed between tied teams;
- (d) Fewest runs allowed vs. common conference opponents (conference-games only);
- (e) Coin toss by the Commissioner.

Two-team Tie

If a two-team tie exists, the following shall be used to determine the seeding for championships:

- (a) Head-to-Head Competition;
- (b) Conference-only record based on winning percentage vs. highest ranked team in conference standings, continuing down in descending order;
- (c) Fewest runs allowed between tied teams (conference-only games);
- (d) Fewest runs allowed vs. common conference opponents (conference-games only);

Here are the scenarios based on the outcome of this week's games.

Coppin State vs. Howard (Wednesday)

Hampton vs. Delaware State (Friday-Saturday)

Hampton University:

Sweeps DSU, Coppin State defeats Howard: Clinches #2 seed outright with 12-6 record. CSU and NSU clinch berths with 10-8 records with CSU seeded #3 and NSU #4 based on 2-1 series record (**Two-team tiebreaker a**).

Sweeps DSU, Howard defeats Coppin State: Clinches #2 seed outright with 12-6 record. NSU is seeded #3 (10-8) and DSU (9-9) is #4 based on 2-1 series record versus Coppin State (9-9) (**Two-team tiebreaker a**).

Wins 2 of 3 over DSU, Coppin State defeats Howard: Finishes 11-7 and clinches #2 seed. CSU, DSU and NSU are all 10-8 with #3 DSU and #4 CSU clinching seeds based on best percentage amongst tied teams (**Multiple team tiebreaker a**).

Wins 2 of 3 over DSU, Howard defeats Coppin State: Finishes 11-7 and clinches #2 seed. DSU and NSU earn berths as both have 10-8 MEAC records with Coppin State finishing 9-9. DSU enters as the #3 while NSU is #4 based on 2-1 series record (**Two-team tiebreaker a**).

Loses 2 of 3 to DSU, Coppin State defeats Howard: Finishes 10-8, Multiple team tiebreaker a takes effect (CSU, NSU, HAMP all are 10-8) as CSU, NSU, HAMP are all 3-3 versus each other. As a result of the tie, multiple team tiebreaker b goes in effect. Against #1 seed Morgan State, Hampton (2-1) and Coppin State (1-2) have the best records with NSU finishing with an 0-3 mark. DSU is #3 and CSU is #4 (**Multiple team tiebreaker b**).

Swept by DSU, Coppin State defeats Howard: Finishes 9-9, #2 DSU (12-6) #3 CSU (10-8), #4 NSU (10-8) clinch seeds as CSU defeated NSU 2-1 in season series (**Two-team tiebreaker a**).

Swept by DSU, Howard defeats Coppin State: Finishes 9-9, #2 DSU (12-6), #3 NSU (10-8) and #4 HAMP (9-9), clinch seeds. Hampton and Coppin State end the year tied at 9-9 with Hampton winning head-to-head series 2-1 (**Two-team tiebreaker a**).

Delaware State University:

Sweeps HAMP, Coppin State defeats Howard: Clinches #2 seed outright with 12-6 record. CSU and NSU clinch berths with 10-8 records with CSU seeded #3 and NSU #4 based on 2-1 series record (**Two-team tiebreaker a**).

Sweeps HAMP, Howard defeats Coppin State: Clinches #2 seed outright with 12-6 record. NSU is seeded #3 (10-8) and HAMP (9-9) is #4 based on 2-1 series record versus Coppin State (9-9) (**Two-team tiebreaker a**).

Wins 2 of 3 over HAMP, Coppin State defeats Howard: Finishes 11-7 and Multiple team tiebreaker a takes effect (CSU, NSU, HAMP all are 10-8) as CSU, NSU, HAMP are all 3-3 versus each other. As a result of the tie, multiple team tiebreaker b goes in effect. Against #1 seed Morgan State, Hampton (2-1) and Coppin State (1-2) have the best records with NSU finishing with an 0-3 mark. DSU is #3 and CSU is #4 (**Multiple team tiebreaker b**).

Wins 2 of 3 over HAMP, Howard defeats Coppin State: Finishes 11-7 and clinches #2 seed. HAMP and NSU earn berths as both have 10-8 MEAC records with Coppin State finishing 9-9. NSU enters as the #3 seed while HAMP is #4 based on NSU winning HAMPTON series by 2-1 record. (**Two-team tiebreaker a**).

Loses 2 of 3 to HAMP, Coppin State defeats Howard: Finishes 10-8, Multiple team tiebreaker a takes effect (CSU, NSU, DSU all are 10-8) as DSU claims #3 seed with the best record (4-2) amongst the three teams followed by #4 CSU (3-3). NSU is out due to a 2-4 record (**Multiple team tiebreaker a**).

Swept by HAMP, Coppin State defeats Howard: Finishes 9-9, #2 HAMP (12-6) #3 CSU (10-8), #4 NSU (10-8) clinch seeds as CSU defeated NSU 2-1 in season series (**Two-team tiebreaker a**).

Swept by HAMP, Howard defeats Coppin State: Finishes 9-9, #2 HAMP (12-6), #3 NSU (10-8) and #4 DSU (9-9), clinch seeds. Delaware State and Coppin State end the year tied at 9-9 with DSU winning head-to-head series 2-1 (**Two-team tiebreaker a**).

MEAC Softball Weekly Honors

Bethune-Cookman's Iesha Waters and **Savannah State's Cortni Jones** were named the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) Softball Co-Players of the Week, the conference announced today. **Morgan State's Amy Begg** and **North Carolina Central's Courtney Mirabella** were named Co-Pitchers of the Week while **Howard's Breanna Robinson** and **Savannah State's Tanisha Williams** have earned Co-Rookie of the Week honors.

Jones (3B, Jr., Snellville, Ga.) finished the week with a .778 average while tallying seven hits, seven RBI, five runs and drawing two walks. She also had two doubles, a triple and a home run while stealing a base. She went 2-for-3 in the first two games at South Carolina State while closing the series out with a 3-for-3 outing which saw her fall a home run short of the cycle. She also added nine assists in the field.

Begg (P, Sr. Christchurch, New Zealand) had another flawless week as she finished 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA. She struck out 12 batters with a pair of complete game shutouts as batters only hit .125 against her. She helped Morgan State clinch the MEAC's Northern Division on Saturday with a shutout before returning to action on Sunday with a one-hit, six-strikeout shutout over rival Coppin State which also included her 500th career strikeout.

Mirabella (P, Sr., Bradenton, Fla.) led the MEAC with 18 strikeouts while compiling a 2-0 record over weekend as North Carolina Central clinched a berth in the upcoming MEAC Championships. She allowed one run in two appearances with a 0.50 ERA. On Sunday, Mirabella threw a one-hit shutout with nine strikeouts.

Robinson (C, Fr., Buena Park, Calif.) had the fourth-highest batting average (.600) in the MEAC this past week as Howard recorded a series sweep over Maryland Eastern Shore. She also had a .636 on-base percentage while scoring three runs, recording four RBI, three doubles and a stolen base. She had two hits in all three games against the Hawks.

Williams (P, Fr., Covington, Ga.) won both of her starts this weekend while finishing with a 0.00 ERA and holding batters to a .093 average. She struck out five batters while only allowing one run and four hits total.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Alexis Bermudez (Bethune-Cookman) picked up three wins in the series versus Florida A&M while posting a 1.20 ERA and allowing only three runs with three strikeouts in 11.2 innings of action.

Madison Didion (Coppin State) struck out 15 on the week with an ERA of 1.10 while recording a shutout.

Jade Dixon (Norfolk State) finished with a .333 average while tallying four hits, three runs, two RBI and two doubles.

Claire Eosso (North Carolina Central) went 6-for-8 to lead NCCU's offense in a three-game sweep of rival North Carolina A&T and clinch a spot in the 2018 MEAC Tournament. Eosso was a perfect 3-for-3 in a 4-1 win, 1-for-2 in a 3-0 win and 2-for-3 with two RBI in a 6-3 win.

Kylee Lopez (Norfolk State) batted .333 in five games and set Norfolk State's single season home run record with 14. She also had a pair of multiple hit games against Longwood and Hampton.

Megan Przeslawski (Norfolk State) went 2-1 on the week with six strikeouts. She had a pair of wins versus Hampton to keep Norfolk State's postseason hopes alive.

Mackenzi Steele (Howard) combined for 14 strikeouts with a 2-0 record and two runs allowed in the series versus Maryland Eastern Shore.

Damali Young (Morgan State) batted .750 with six hits, three runs scored, a double, triple and four stolen bases to add to her school record 96 stolen bases in a key series win over Coppin State.

MEAC ANNOUNCES SOFTBALL PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE HONORS

The Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) has announced that Morgan State's Amy Begg has been selected as the conference's Preseason Pitcher of the Year while Bethune-Cookman's Ryan Jackson was tabbed Preseason Player of the Year. Ten institutions were represented on the team led by Bethune-Cookman's five selections. Delaware State, Florida A&M and Maryland Eastern Shore each had three selections while Hampton, Morgan State and North Carolina A&T State had two apiece.

All preseason honors were voted on by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors.

A senior from Christchurch, New Zealand, Begg led the MEAC with 179 strikeouts and 20 wins on the mound as she posted a 2.31 ERA in 2017. A five-time MEAC Pitcher of the Week, Begg also led the league with seven shutouts and finished second in opponent batting average (.227). In her three-year career at Morgan State, Begg has amassed a total of 389 strikeouts.

Jackson was named the MEAC's Player and Rookie of the Year in 2017 as she led the MEAC in batting average (.408), home runs (14), RBIs (47), total bases (118), on-base percentage (.483) and slugging percentage (.771). A three-time MEAC Player of the Week and two-time Rookie of the Week, the Chino Hills, Calif. native was also named to the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Division I National Freshman of the Year Top 25.

The 2018 season begins on Friday, Feb. 9 with the first conference matchup scheduled for March 17. The MEAC Tournament returns to Ormond Beach, Fla. and begins on May 9.
