### NOTES

• MEAC softball begins week seven as conference play is in full effect for both divisions. After the first weekend of league play, Delaware State was the only team to conclude the opening weekend of league play unscathed.

• The Hampton Lady Pirates and the Florida A&M Lady Rattlers were predicted to win the MEAC softball Northern and Southern Divisions, respectively. Delaware State was picked to finish second behind the Lady Pirates in a tight race as they received 10 first-place votes and 153 total points. Pollsters predicted another showdown between FAMU and rival Bethune-Cookman as the Wildcats were picked second after receiving 10 first-place votes and 130 total points.

• Three teams have won more than 10 games as Bethune-Cookman leads the way with 14 wins while Hampton and Norfolk State have 11 apiece.

• Hampton's **DaSha Hill** leads the league in batting average with a .492 clip and is tied for second with 32 hits and second with two triples. Hill is also a terror on the bases as she's 26-of-26 in stolen base attempts. Preseason Player of the Year **Ryan Jackson** of Bethune-Cookman has 35 hits, 30 runs, 26 RBIs and 11 home runs to go along with a .376 average.

• **Courtney Mirabella** of North Carolina Central is obliterating opposing batters with 110 strikeouts in 13 games played. Her 20 strikeouts in a 4-0 win over Maryland Eastern Shore was one strikeout shy of the NCAA Division I record for strikeouts in a regulation seven-inning game. Coppin State's **Madison Didion** ranks second with 66 strikeouts while Preseason Pitcher of the Year **Amy Begg** follows with 58.

• The 2018 MEAC Tournament takes place once again in Ormond Beach, Fla. as Bethune-Cookman will host the tournament.

## MEAC Softball Weekly Honors

**Delaware State's Desiree Moreno** was selected as the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) Softball Player of the Week, the conference announced today. **Coppin State's Madison Didion** and **Hampton's Allyson Babinsack** shared Co-Pitcher of the Week honors while **Nia Bowe of Coppin State** and **Alyssa Diaz of Delaware State** were named Co-Rookies of the Week.

**Moreno (C, So., Carson, Calif.)** batted .429 (6-of-14) with a league-best eight RBI and 12 total bases as the Hornets opened MEAC play with a three-game sweep over Maryland Eastern Shore. She also totaled four runs while belting two home runs. Moreno opened the series with a bang as she went 3-for-5 with five RBI, two runs scored and a home run while following her performance in game two of Saturday's doubleheader with another 3-for-5 performance which included three RBI, two runs and a homer.

**Bowe (OF, Fr., Milford, Del.)** ranked second in the MEAC with seven RBI while tying for the lead in home runs with two. She also ranked second in total bases with 11. Bowe made her MEAC debut in style as she hit two home runs while driving in four RBI with a pair of runs against Norfolk State.

**Diaz (SS, Fr., Fontana, Calif.)** batted .625 (5-for-8) with five RBI while drawing a pair of walks and a stolen base. In the opening game of Saturday's doubleheader versus Maryland Eastern Shore, Diaz finished 3-for-3 with three RBIs and a stolen base while recording five assists in the field.

**Babinsack (P, Jr., Hampton, Va.)** led Hampton to a pair of wins over Morgan State this past weekend as she held the Bears to a .196 average while recording four strikeouts and allowing only three runs.

**Didion (P, Jr., Montesano, Wis.)** struck out a MEAC-best 24 batters while compiling a 2-1 record and a 3.67 ERA over the past week. She opened the week with eight strikeouts versus Albany while combining to fan 16 in a pair of wins over Norfolk State.

### Other Top Performers

**Hunter Halford (Norfolk State)** posted a 1-0 record with four strikeouts versus Coppin State.

**Jazzmine Hammond (Norfolk State)** stole three bases during Norfolk State's three-game series against Coppin State.

**DaSha Hill (Hampton)** batted .625 with five hits and four stolen bases as Hampton claimed two wins over Morgan State.

**Ryan Jackson (Bethune-Cookman)** hit a team-high tying .571 last week while hitting her 11th home run in two games versus George Mason.

**Jaylene Pryor (Norfolk State)** finished the week with a .667 average as she also recorded six hits and three doubles.

**Stephanie Rundlett (Morgan State)** struck out 16 batters and recorded a save in three games.

**Patricia Soria (Coppin State)** drove in four RBI while batting .467 in five games last week.

# MEAC ANNOUNCES SOFTBALL PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE HONORS

The Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) has announced that Morgan State's Amy Begg has been selected as the conference's Preseason Pitcher of the Year while Bethune-Cookman's Ryan Jackson was tabbed Preseason Player of the Year. Ten institutions were represented on the team led by Bethune-Cookman's five selections. Delaware State, Florida A&M and Maryland Eastern Shore each had three selections while Hampton, Morgan State and North Carolina A&T State had two apiece.

All preseason honors were voted on by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors.

A senior from Christchurch, New Zealand, Begg led the MEAC with 179 strikeouts and 20 wins on the mound as she posted a 2.31 ERA in 2017. A five-time MEAC Pitcher of the Week, Begg also led the league with seven shutouts and finished second in opponent batting average (.227). In her three-year career at Morgan State, Begg has amassed a total of 389 strikeouts.

Jackson was named the MEAC's Player and Rookie of the Year in 2017 as she led the MEAC in batting average (.408), home runs (14), RBIs (47), total bases (118), on-base percentage (.483) and slugging percentage (.771). A three-time MEAC Player of the Week and two-time Rookie of the Week, the Chino Hills, Calif. native was also named to the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Division I National Freshman of the Year Top 25.

The 2018 season begins on Friday, Feb. 9 with the first conference matchup scheduled for March 17. The MEAC Tournament returns to Ormond Beach, Fla. and begins on May 9.
