NOTES

- MEAC softball begins week 12 as only two weeks remain in the regular season.
- The Hampton Lady Pirates and the Florida A&M Lady Rattlers were predicted to win the MEAC softball Northern and Southern Divisions, respectively. Florida A&M has won four consecutive MEAC Championships while Hampton has two championships all-time.
- Morgan State remains in the Northern Division driver's seat after its three-game sweep over Maryland Eastern Shore. A sweep this weekend would tie a school record for conference wins (16). The Bears can clinch the Northern Division outright with two wins this weekend over Coppin State or a share with one win. If the Lady Bears are swept and Hampton wins its final six games, Hampton would clinch the Northern Division title. If both teams are tied, Hampton wins the division based on a 2-1 in record in the head-to-head match-up.
- To no surprise, Florida A&M and Bethune-Cookman will battle for the Southern Division title once again. If the Lady Rattlers win one game against BCU this weekend, they'll clinch the crown outright. BCU would win the division if they sweep FAMU.
- While the divisional championships are at stake this weekend, seeding and post-season berths are also at stake. Norfolk State, Coppin State and Delaware State are all fighting postseason berths as only one game separates the trio in the north. In the south, North Carolina A&T State, North Carolina Central and Savannah State are fighting for postseason berths as Savannah State is two games ahead of North Carolina A&T State and a game on top of NCCU.
- **DaSha Hill** of Hampton leads the MEAC with a .432 average while also accounting for 48 hits and is 40-of-42 in stolen bases. North Carolina Central's **Ava Dolan** ranks second with a .423 average while compiling 44 hits, 37 RBI and 22 runs. Savannah State's **Brianna Harris** ranks third with a .416 average followed by Coppin State freshman **Nia Bowe** (.409 average, 38 hits, 31 RBIs and 24 runs. Bethune-Cookman's **Ryan Jackson** leads the MEAC with 111 total bases.
- **Courtney Mirabella** of North Carolina Central is obliterating opposing batters with 256 strikeouts followed by Coppin State's **Madison Didion** (141) and Florida A&M's **Kyaira Brown** (113). Brown leads the MEAC with 13 wins total and has won 10 straight.
- The 2018 MEAC Tournament takes place once again in Ormond Beach, Fla. as Bethune-Cookman will host the tournament. The top four teams from each division make the conference tournament.

MEAC Softball Weekly Honors

Hampton's Alana VanDenburg was named the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) Softball Player of the Week, the conference announced today. **Morgan State's Amy Begg** and **North Carolina Central's Courtney Mirabella** were named Co-Pitchers of the Week while **Howard's Trinity Gibbs** was selected as Rookie of the Week.

VanDenburg (OF, Sr., Wynantskill, N.Y.) batted .400 (6-of-15) in five games this past week as the Lady Pirates finished 4-1. The senior outfielder recorded a pair of RBI while stealing three bases with two runs, a double and a triple. She finished 2-for-3 in games against North Carolina Central and Coppin State last week while driving in the game's first run in a 2-0 decision over NCCU.

Begg (P, Sr. Christchurch, New Zealand) had a flawless week as she finished 3-0 with a 0.00 ERA. She struck out 15 batters with three complete games while allowing only two runs and holding batters to a .088 average. Begg pitched a two-hit shutout in the win over Villanova while combining to strike out 13 with no earned runs in two wins versus Maryland Eastern Shore.

Mirabella (P, Sr., Bradenton, Fla.) posted a 4-1 record last week while striking out 46 batters with a .097 ERA. She opened the week with a 13-strikeout outing at Norfolk State while throwing a no-hitter at South Carolina State. She fanned 27 batters in the S.C. State series, 17 versus Norfolk State and two at Hampton.

Gibbs (OF, Fr., Kissimmee, Fla.) recorded a .625 average with five hits, three RBI, two doubles and two runs in Howard's series versus Delaware State. She posted a .700 on-base percentage and an .875 slugging percentage.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Allyson Babinsack (Hampton) struck out 12 batters with an .067 ERA as she finished 3-0 with three complete games last week.

Nia Bowe (Coppin State) hit a home run and stole a base in the contest versus Hampton.

Cayla Brown (Coppin State) hit .400 with six hits and was 3-for-3 in the series finale at Hampton.

Kyaira Brown (Florida A&M) pitched a complete game in a 2-1 win over North Florida while striking out seven with no walks allowed. She has won 10 consecutive contests dating back to March 17.

Madison Didion (Coppin State) struck out 26 in four games while recording an ERA of 1.47.

Hunter Halford (Norfolk State) went 1-1 with a shutout win over North Carolina Central.

Amanda Hallman (Savannah State) went 2-0 with a 0.50 ERA and 10 strikeouts in two games.

Cortni Jones (Savannah State) recorded a .400 (4-for-10) batting average with three runs scored, five RBI, a double and a home run in a 3-0 series sweep against North Carolina A&T State.

Anissa Morales (Morgan State) combined for six RBI, four stolen bases and three hits in four games last week.

Seana Moriarty (Norfolk State) batted .556 (5-of-9) with nine fielding assists in four games last week.

Kayla Porter (Norfolk State) posted a 1.00 ERA with three strikeouts in a contest versus North Carolina Central.

Mackenzi Steele (Howard) combined for 11 strikeouts in the series versus Delaware State.

MEAC ANNOUNCES SOFTBALL PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE HONORS

The Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) has announced that Morgan State's Amy Begg has been selected as the conference's Preseason Pitcher of the Year while Bethune-Cookman's Ryan Jackson was tabbed Preseason Player of the Year. Ten institutions were represented on the team led by Bethune-Cookman's five selections. Delaware State, Florida A&M and Maryland Eastern Shore each had three selections while Hampton, Morgan State and North Carolina A&T State had two apiece.

All preseason honors were voted on by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors.

A senior from Christchurch, New Zealand, Begg led the MEAC with 179 strikeouts and 20 wins on the mound as she posted a 2.31 ERA in 2017. A five-time MEAC Pitcher of the Week, Begg also led the league with seven shutouts and finished second in opponent batting average (.227). In her three-year career at Morgan State, Begg has amassed a total of 389 strikeouts.

Jackson was named the MEAC's Player and Rookie of the Year in 2017 as she led the MEAC in batting average (.408), home runs (14), RBIs (47), total bases (118), on-base percentage (.483) and slugging percentage (.771). A three-time MEAC Player of the Week and two-time Rookie of the Week, the Chino Hills, Calif. native was also named to the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Division I National Freshman of the Year Top 25.

The 2018 season begins on Friday, Feb. 9 with the first conference matchup scheduled for March 17. The MEAC Tournament returns to Ormond Beach, Fla. and begins on May 9.
